SYNOPSIS:

A 1992 Ford Explorer, FL tag 750XYF, being driven by Qushania M. Vaughn (B/F, 06/03/1988, 1335 Prescott Street South) was eastbound on 5th Avenue South. A small sedan was southbound on 22nd Avenue South. The sedan ran the red light and struck the Ford, sending the Ford off the southeast corner of the intersection. Vaughn and her two children, Adrian Nesbitt (B/M, 09/29/2006) and Audrey Nesbitt (B/F, 06/24/2008) were properly restrained in their vehicle and rode the collision out. They refused medical treatment at the scene, but later stated they would seek medical attention on their own.

The sedan fled the scene. A few hours later, Stephanie Pringle (W/F, 03/19/1975, 1825 Auburn Street South) was delivered to Largo Medical Center in critical condition. She was then airlifted to Tampa General Hospital in life-threatening condition. Largo Police responded to Largo Medical Condition where it was determined Pringle was the passenger in the vehicle which fled the scene of the crash in St. Petersburg. No one else in the crash has been positively identified or interviewed, nor has the Hit and Run vehicle been located.
