Updated Information: St. Petersburg Police Investigation of a Stabbing

Arrested: Donald Wynn, DOB: 4-2-57, 1825 1/2 17th Street South.

Victim: Donald Gilley, DOB: 10-8-85, same address.

On Friday October 14, 2011 at 10:05 a.m., the St. Petersburg Police Department received a call of a stabbing at 1825 1/2 17th Street South.

Officers and Fire Rescue personnel arrived at the scene at 10:08 a.m. and found the victim, Donald Gilley, with multiple stab wounds to his abdomen, upper chest and lower abdomen.

The weapon was described as a folding-blade pocket knife.

(The victim, Donald Gilley, is the biological son of the suspect, Donald Wynn. His last name is different because he took his mother's name and, until recently, had been estranged from his father.)

Gilley was transported to Bayfront Medical Center as a trauma alert. He received emergency surgery to save his life and is now listed in critical but stable condition.

The suspect told police investigators that he accused his son of stealing some personal belongings from him, including a can of lima beans, then became angry and stabbed him multiple times.

Donald Wynn has been transported to the Pinellas County Jail where he is booked on a charge of Attempted Murder in the First Degree.
