Police Close Twenty Vehicle Burglaries With Three Arrests

Incident: Vehicle Burglaries/Auto Theft

Location: Mostly in the Northeast Side of the City

Date: September 30, 2009

St. Petersburg Police closed twenty burglaries to vehicles with the arrest of three suspects over night after multiple vehicle burglaries were reported.

Officers responded to seven vehicle burglaries, four attempt vehicle burglaries, and one auto theft between midnight and 4:00 a.m. The burglaries occurred mostly in the Northeast section of the city. As the officers were investigating the auto theft, undercover units observed a silver Chrysler Town & Country mini van with three black males inside. The same type of vehicle seen was involved in other vehicle burglaries in the Northeast area. The covert unit followed them and witnessed these suspects commit several more break ins . This brought the total for the night to twenty burglaries.
