What and How

Redistricting is the process by which the legislative body equalizes differences in the population of districts by making adjustments to district boundaries.

Redistricting \neq Reapportionment

Why?

Direction to redistrict is found in City's Charter

- Redistricting Report – Office of the Mayor
- Citizens Redistricting Commission – City Council

Furtheres the principal of “one person, one vote”
and right to vote

- 14th Amendment (1868)
- 15th Amendment (1870)
- Voting Rights Act (1965)

General Guidelines for Redistricting

General Guidelines

- **Substantially equal in population**
- Don't dilute minority voting strength
- Follow census blocks
- Must be contiguous
- Should follow significant boundaries
- Should be compact
- Should preserve communities of interest
- Should follow charter-specific criteria
 - ✓ Neighborhoods
 - ✓ 4.75 point range

General Guidelines

*Individual criteria and guidelines are
balanced in concert with each other*

General Guidelines - Population

Districts should be as nearly equal in population as is “possible” or “practicable”

* As equal in population as “possible” or “practicable”

Population \neq Registered Voters

Absolute population equality is impossible...minimize the deviation from the mean

May under populate fast-growing areas

General criteria: Avoid plans with range in deviation spread of over 10 percentage points

✓ Charter Criteria: 4.75 percentage points

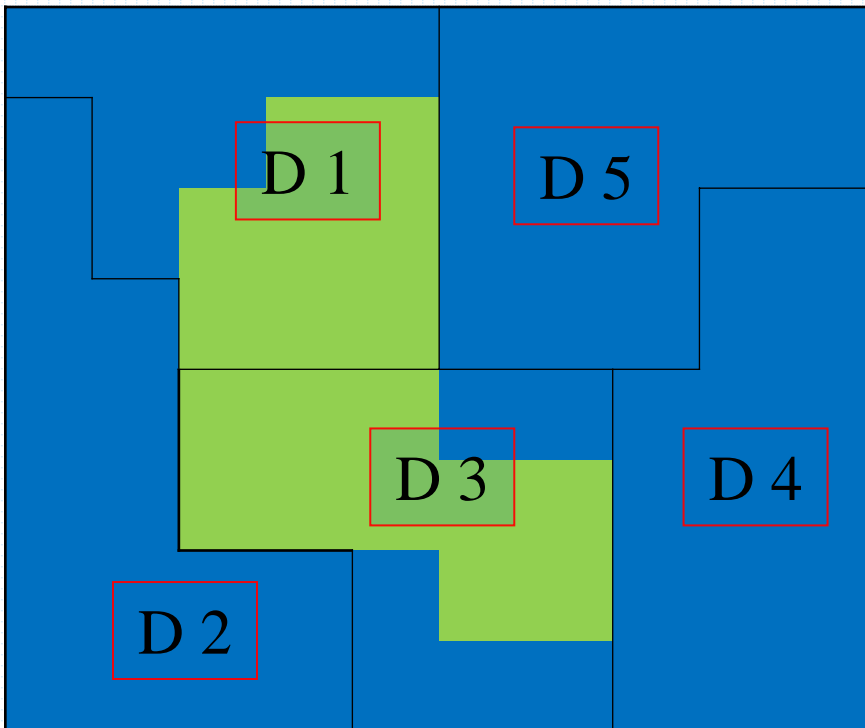
Don't Dilute Minority Voting Strength

Packing – locating most of minority population into one district so as to dilute influence in other districts

Cracking – splitting minority population into two or more districts so as to dilute influence in all districts

Don't Dilute Minority Voting Strength

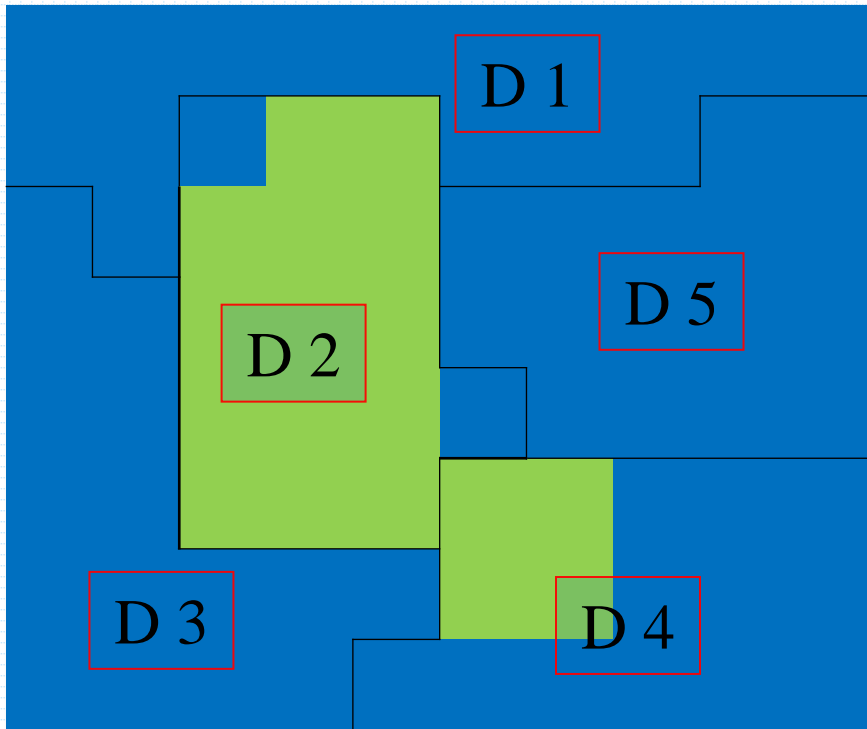
Example City's population is 22.5% Green and 77.5% Blue. Below shows a relatively even distribution of blue and green residents into five districts.

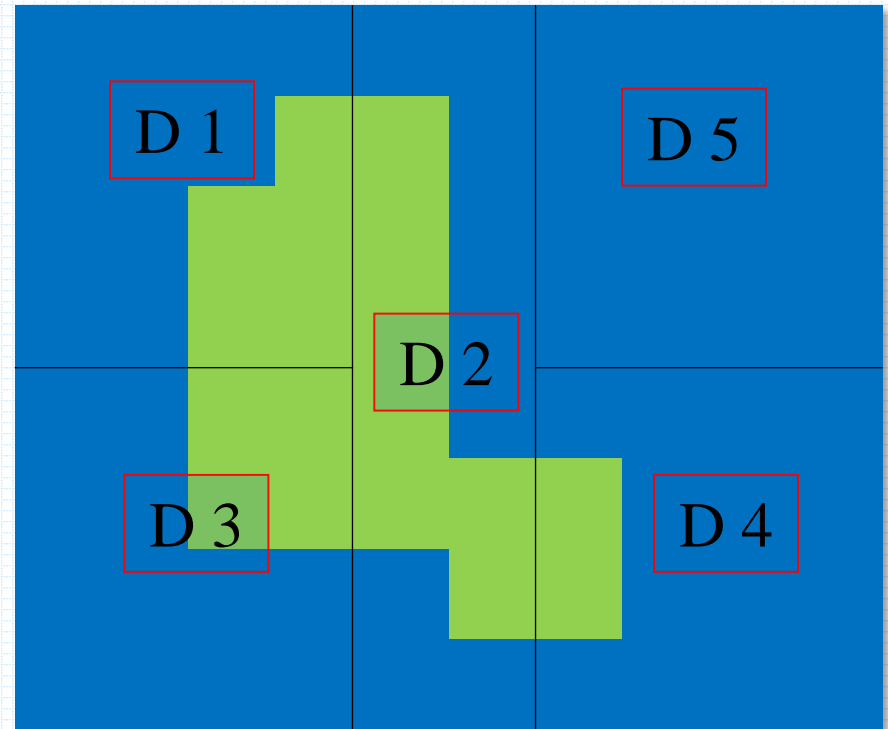
Don't Dilute Minority Voting Strength

Packing: 4 blue, 1 green



Green population concentrated in one district (87.5% in D2)

Cracking: 4 blue, 1 green influence



Green population split among four districts (43.75% in D2)

Use Census Blocks and Data

Readily available

Smallest unit of “building blocks”

Presumed to be valid...but look for anomalies

May be altered or supplemented with other sources of data but must document valid reasons why/how

Total population v. 18+ years

Must be Contiguous

In total, Districts must cover the entire area of the City

All portions of each District must be contiguous to each other

- ✓ Contiguity may be maintained by crossing a waterbody

Follow Significant Boundaries

District should minimize disruption to existing district boundaries and follow significant natural or artificial features or boundaries (roads, waterbodies, etc.)

- ✓ Easier to understand for voters
- ✓ Recognizes will of voters who elected incumbent
- ✓ Less disruptive to voting precincts
- ✓ Usually coterminous with census block boundaries

Follow Significant Boundaries

District shapes should be relatively compact

Should avoid creating districts or districting plans with “bizarre” or “serpentine” shapes without valid underlying public purpose

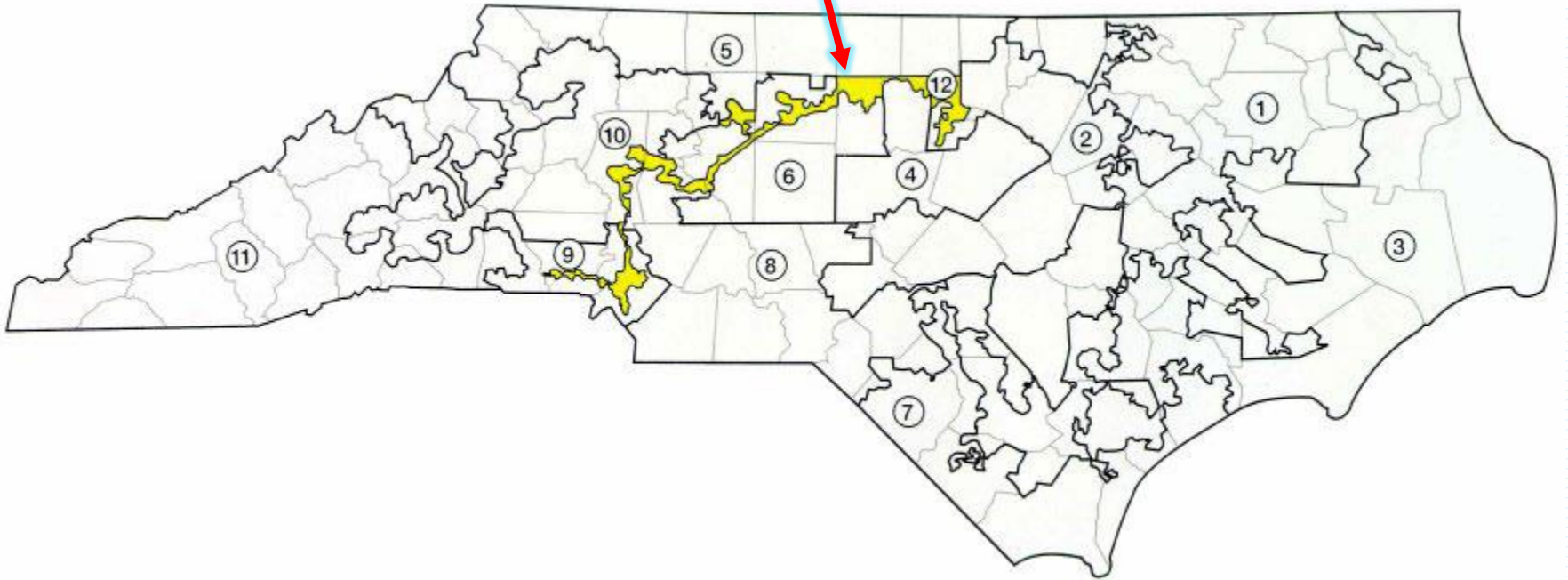

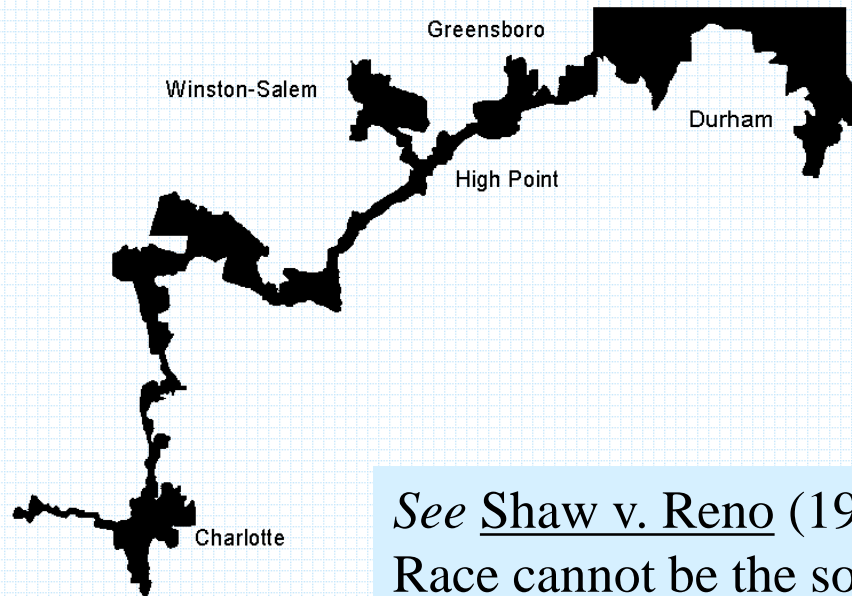

Preserve Communities of Interest

District boundaries should avoid splitting or dividing communities of interest, neighborhoods or HOAs

- ✓ Preservation of neighborhoods = intent of Charter

District boundaries should minimize the number of residents moved out of an existing district

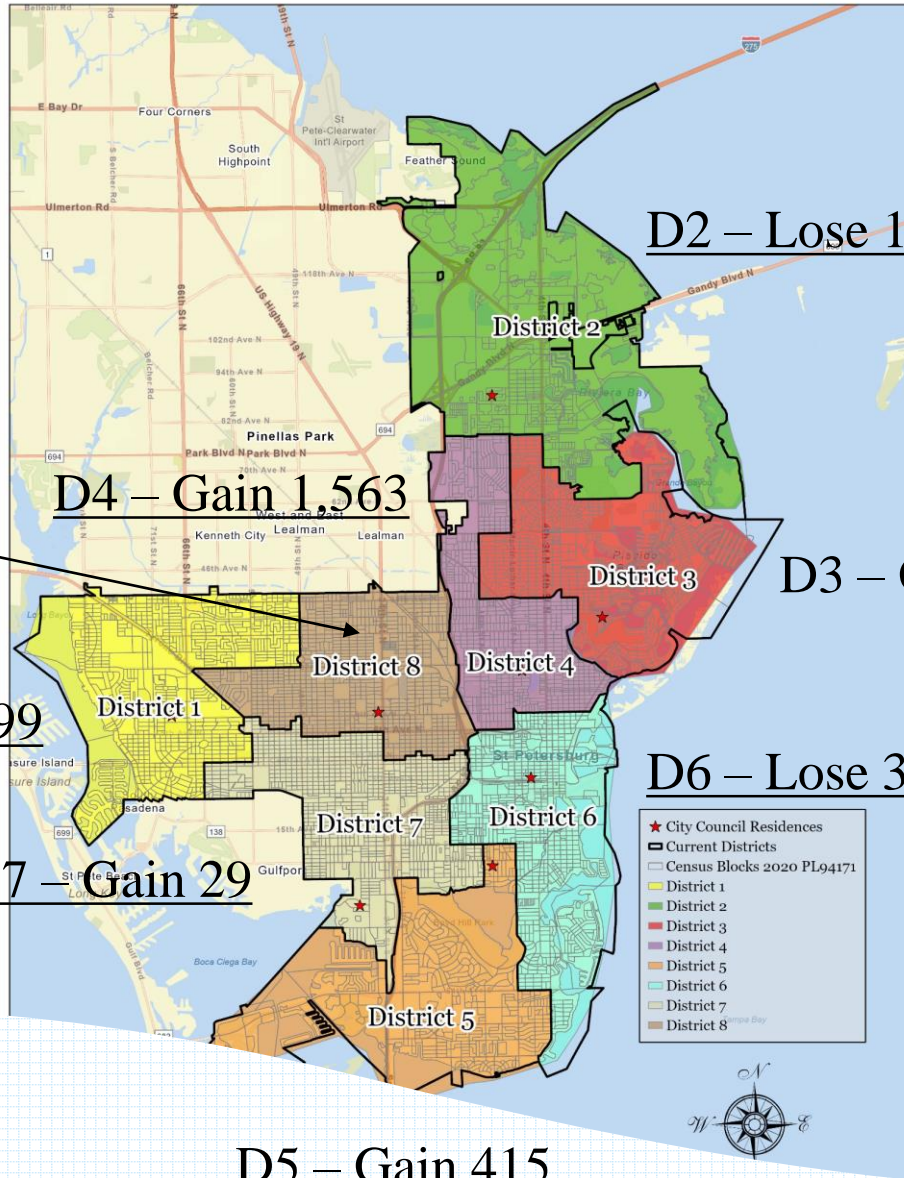

General Guidelines

- It is impossible to develop a redistricting plan that attains 100% compliance with each criteria
- Individual criteria are balanced in concert with each other, with population being the dominant criterion

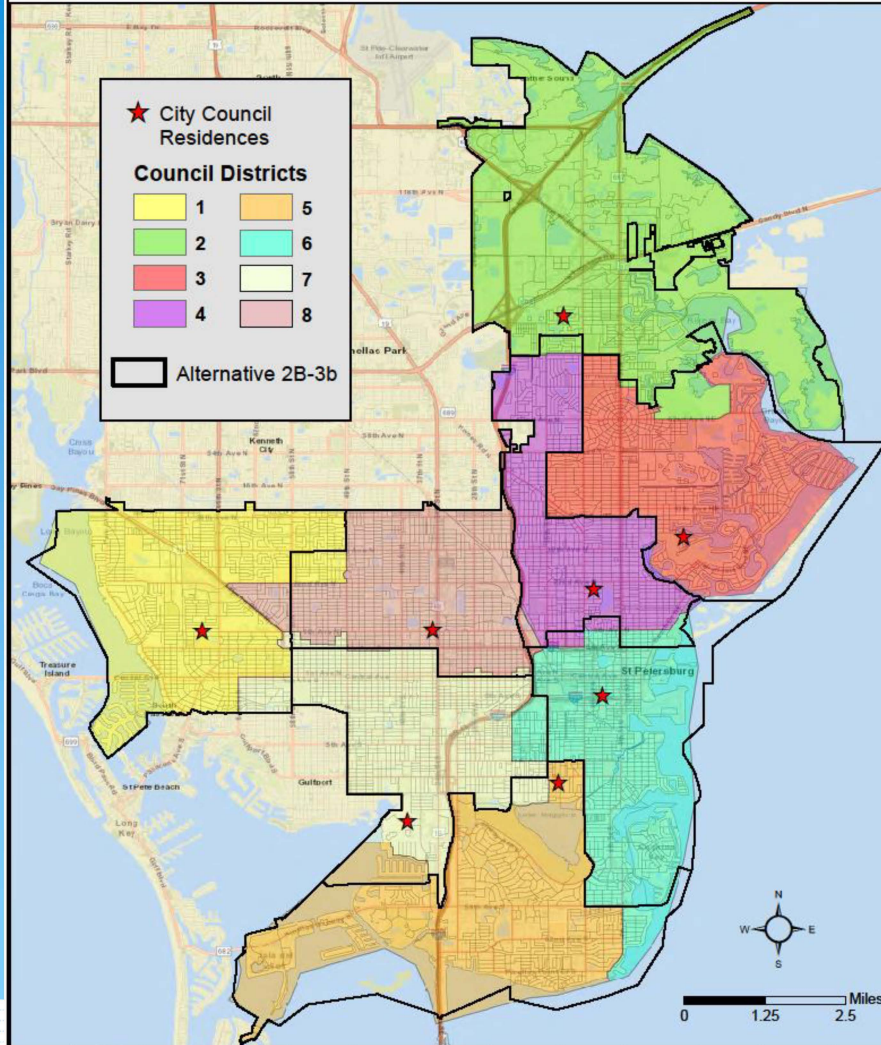
