**SUPPLEMENTAL FIREFIGHTER'S RETIREMENT SYSTEM OF THE CITY**  
**SUMMARY OF MATERIAL MODIFICATION TO**  
**THE SUMMARY PLAN DESCRIPTION**

This summary of material modification ("**SMM**") describes changes to the Supplemental Firefighter's Retirement System of the City ("**Plan**") that were made by Ordinance 438-H approved by City Council on August 6, 2020.

This SMM supplements the Summary Plan Description ("**SPD**") for the Plan. Read this SMM carefully and retain this document with your copy of the SPD for future reference.

**Summary of Changes:**

1) A member's Earnings Base is considered in the computation of retirement benefits. Earnings Base is the average monthly Earnable Compensation (Covered Salary) during a member's highest three years of creditable service. The Plan was amended to increase the annual amount of overtime hours and certain other pays included in Earnable Compensation as follows:

**On or after January 1, 2020, but before September 28, 2020 – Base pay plus driver engineer pay, if any; hazardous materials response team pay, if any; marine team pay, if any; technical rescue assignment pay, if any; tactical team TAC pay, if any and up to 100 hours of overtime per fiscal year.**

**On or after September 28, 2020 – Base pay plus driver engineer pay, if any; hazardous materials response team pay, if any; marine team pay, if any; technical rescue assignment pay, if any; tactical team TAC pay, if any and up to 120 hours of overtime per fiscal year.**
