

Jun. 2016
City contracts with HKS Architects to develop a conceptual master plan for the redevelopment of the Tropicana Field Site. Engagement during this process included participation from hundreds of adult and youth residents.

Nov. 2018
Scenario 2, redevelopment of the site without a ballpark, is completed.

Nov. 2019
Collaborative team of City, business, and community leaders kicks-off the Bloomberg-Harvard City Leadership Initiative to plan for the equitable redevelopment of the site.

Mar. 2020
Duke Energy releases a Site Readiness Report for the site relating to infrastructure, workforce, and targeted industries.

Jan. 2021
Seven qualified proposals are received from potential development partners.

Mar. 2021
Mayor Kriseman will shortlist the proposals; the shortlisted proposers will engage in community presentations and the

May/June. 2021
Mayor Kriseman will select a development partner.

Mar. 2017
Scenario 1, redevelopment of the site with a new ballpark, is completed.

Jun. 2019
The City, in partnership with VHB, releases a study of best practices for sustainability & resiliency, healthy communities, and smart city technology related to the redevelopment of the site.

Jan. 2020
A core team traveled to New York for intensive training on cross-collaboration best practices and engagement.

Jul. 2020
The City releases a Request for Proposals for the redevelopment of the site.

Feb. 2021
Community input on the proposals will be collected and shared with Mayor Kriseman for consideration.

Sept./Oct. 2021
A development agreement with the selected development partner
