

## CITY OF ST. PETERSBURG EMERGENCY SOLUTIONS GRANT PROGRAM

### AMENDMENT TO ACTION PLAN

Notice is hereby given that the City of St. Petersburg ("City") is eligible to receive \$54,584 in funding under the Homeless Emergency Assistance and Rapid Transition to Housing Act of 2009 from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development ("HUD"). Funding will be provided through the Emergency Solutions Grant ("ESG"). The program will provide for financial assistance and services to prevent persons from becoming homeless and help those who are homeless to be re-housed and stabilized in the form of the following services:

- Financial Assistance for Homeless Prevention
- Financial Assistance for Rapid Re-Housing
- Housing Relocation and Stabilization Services for Homeless Prevention
- Housing Relocation and Stabilization Services for Rapid Re-Housing
- Data Collection and Evaluation
- Administration

The City will accept applications from experienced and qualified non-profit agencies that assist homeless persons with the provision of the above listed services between March 12, 2012 and April 20, 2012. Application forms can be picked up at the Housing and Community Development Department located at One Fourth Street North, Third Floor, St. Petersburg or on the Department's website located at: [www.stpete.org/housing/housedoc.asp](http://www.stpete.org/housing/housedoc.asp).

All completed applications for funding must be received at the Housing and Community Development Department reception desk at One Fourth Street North, Third Floor, by 4:00 p.m. on Friday, April 20, 2012 in order to be considered for funding. (FAX copies will not be accepted.)

The City intends to hold a public hearing on May 3, 2012 at 9:00 a.m., at City Hall located at 175 5<sup>th</sup> Street North, St. Petersburg, Florida, to approve a substantial amendment to the FY 2011/12 Action Plan. This will enable the City to access the \$54,584 of funding available for allocation to the City.
